3) How many people in the world live on less than \$2 a day?

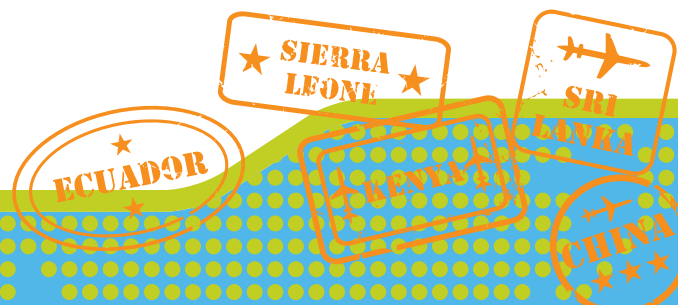
- A. 1,000 people

7) Which of the following is not a Free The Children development program?

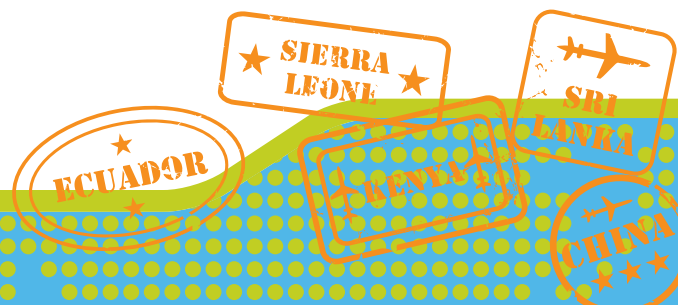
- A. Building clean water wells

More than one million working children have been bought or sold into slavery. Often, children are sold into slavery by their parents when they can't afford their family's basic needs for survival, or when they are threatened by debts that they can't pay. Free The Children's programs help families so they are able to meet their needs, protect their children and send them to school.

9) Which of the following resources does Free The Children give to women?

Answer = A,B and C

A, B and C provide steady sources of income for women so that they can send their kids to school. Goats and cows provide them with milk that they can drink or sell and sewing machines allow them to make clothes to sell.

Answer = D
